It is an active waiting in which we live the present moment to the full in order to find there the signs of the One we are waiting for.

- In St. Albert, parish Vespers (evening prayer) will be celebrated on Friday evenings. One could take part in this form of prayer.
- Do a kind deed for someone who needs some help.




